

NYLT PERSONAL EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

The official Boy Scouts of America field uniform and accessories are required. This includes Venturing, Varsity, Ship and Explorer field uniforms. If you do not have all the parts of the uniform try to borrow them. If there is still an issue with obtaining the complete uniform please contact the Course Director.

Everyone will be in field uniform upon arrival to camp (see first 4 items on the required list).

You should pack as if preparing for an overnight hike as well as living in camp. At least one pair of shoes must be suitable for hiking. Place your name on all clothing and personal items. Any items that you do not own, please try to borrow. A hiking backpack or frame will be used for carrying gear from the parking lot to the campsite and to the overnight campsite.

Please review the list of PROHIBITED ITEMS below.

CLOTHING:

- BSA Field Uniform shirt
- BSA Field Uniform pants or shorts
- BSA uniform socks (2 pair minimum)
- Belt – BSA or plain (leather or web)
- 2 Extra BSA (Class B) or plain t-shirts
- Swim Suit
- Hiking boots
- Extra shoes
- Extra pants or shorts
- Underwear (4 minimum)
- Sleepwear
- Rain suit or rain poncho

Provided at check-in:

(Extras can be purchased)

- NYLT Official t-shirt (2 provided)
- NYLT Official cap (1 provided)

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- Trunks, footlockers or suitcases
- Electronics (Cell phones, ...)
- Food (unless approved for dietary need)
- Knife / Lighter / Matches / Fireworks
- Open toed shoes

PERSONAL ITEMS:

- Mess Kit (plate, bowl, cup, fork, spoon)
- Water Bottle 1L
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Hand soap / body wash / shampoo
- Towel & washcloth
- Pool towel
- Comb or brush
- Prescribed medication (See **NOTE**)
- Personal first aid kit
- Sun screen & lip balm
- Pen and/or pencils

CAMPING EQUIPMENT:

- Sleeping bag or light weight blanket
- Sleeping pad
- Small flashlight & spare batteries
- Sunglasses
- Watch
- Camp stool or chair
- Laundry soap, clothes line & clothespins
- Insect repellent (non-aerosol)

* Borrow if you do not own:

- * Hiking backpack with hip belt
- * 2 man tent with stakes.
- Waterproof ground cloth

NOTE: Prescription Medications must be turned in to the course medical officer at check-in. We will make a checklist; however, each Scout must keep track of their own needs and see the medical officer whenever they need medications. Scouts may bring their own over the counter medicines (Tylenol, cold tablets, antacids, etc.) These must be kept in their pack.
